## Debate22 report

In order to succeed , your desire of success should be greater than your fear of failure. Overcoming all the challenges posed by the Covid-19, Fr. Conceicao Rodrigues College of Engineering has successfully hosted its Flagship event, Conceicao Rodrigues Memorial Debate (CRMD), from 8th to 10th of October , 2021. Again the event was held online but that did not take away the enthusiasm professed by the debaters or the judges who partook in this prestigious event. Identifying the indifference between the set of practices and moral values prevalent in the modern world , the theme for CRMD 2021 was – *“The Emanation of Unbecoming Comportment”* CRMD is an intermediate Oxford-style debate competition and has always been praised by people who have witnessed it. Teams from all over India eagerly anticipate bagging the esteemed trophy with their debating intrepidity. The event was hosted on two popular video conferencing platforms, Google Meet and Zoom. The Semi-finals and Final debates were live on YouTube as well to ensure an immersive experience for all our viewers. The much-anticipated debate had 32 laudable teams from all over the nation, grappling with their words for the first prize of Rs. 50,000, second prize for 30,000 and Rs. 10,000 for the best speaker and the best adjudicator. Teams from more than 15 states competed hard through the league rounds to acquire their positions in the quarter-finals. Not only centring on the strengths and weaknesses of an argument but also providing frank but constructive feedback to each team to help them better, our Judges, who included experts from the field of Communication, Education, and Corporate world, judged every debate with immense grace and eloquence. Weighing every argument with equanimity, and deciding rankings in the house, an Adjudicator plays a vital role. Our Adjudicators consciously noted down all considerable points put forth by the debaters and provided them with productive feedback for the same. With astute arguments, the top 8 teams battled their way in quarters, putting forth excellent points. 4 teams emerged victoriously from the war of words and were qualified for the semi-finals.

Mr. Anirudh Srinivasan is currently a Marketing Manager with Fujitsu, a Japanese Digital Transformation company, where he focuses on Emerging Technology solutions such as Artificial

Intelligence, Quantum Computing and Blockchain.

Dr.Arпита Pal Choudary is the Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Engineering Sciences at Ramrao Adik Institute of Technology, D.Y Patil Deemed to be University and have More than 25 years of experience in teaching and research.

Dr. Suma Shreedhar is currently working for AP Shah Institute of technology as Assistant Professor since 2016 and has Completed doctorate in English from JJTU and MS in counselling and psychotherapy from Chittor university having more than 16 years of teaching experience.

Mr.Sashankh Kale comes from a research and consulting background having close to 18 years of work experience and is currently in a corporate strategy role at Gainwell Technologies, a US healthcare IT solutions company.

The teams competed flawlessly in the semi-final rounds, proving their skills for the dialectic dispute. The finest 2 teams made their way to the finals.

Articulating the roots of beliefs and opinions, the 2 teams in the final round showcased their endowment of deploying lucid and logical arguments following the given motion -

Dr. Abha Jha, is presently teaching Business Communication and Ethics in THADOMAL Shahani Engineering college, Bandra. She has taught in FRCRCE between 2008-2011.

Mr.Jagjyot Singh is businessman by profession and has participated in this debate competition for 4 years and have won all four years consecutively and also won best speaker in all four years . He has had a very close relationship with the institute and it's professors and students over the years.

Mr. Mihir Karkare is an alumni of this college and have successfully completed computer engineering in the 2007 batch and has also been part of the CRCE debate team in his final year . He believes that the debating skills he developed during those days have served as a strong underpinning in his life and career.

In every battle there comes a time when both sides consider themselves beaten, then he who continues the attack wins. Side Opposition, Team CMD03 (NMIMS MPSTME) emerged triumphant in the prestigious battle of CRMD this year.

### Heart & Sole Run 4 on Virtual platform – 2020-21

A lump sum of **450+ participants** nationwide along with Rotaract Club of Fr. CRCE contributed and made a much needed difference in the society. Despite the limitations and extreme hardships caused by the global pandemic, Rotaract Club of Fr. CRCE has still managed to organize yet another edition of its flagship event **The Heart and Sole Run 4**, which took place on the 13th and 14th of March, 2021 going Pan-India this year.

The run was organized in association with two NGO's Community Outreach Program and Fr Agnel Ashram. Community Outreach Programme has worked to provide a platform for the holistic development of women, children, and the communities in which they live. They provide residents with critical services, focused on supporting at-risk children and empowering women. These services include access to quality education, shelter, nutritious meals, health services, and the means to better lives through vocational training. Fr. Agnel Ashram has been working constantly towards providing for the under privileged children over decades and we are proud to support them in this noble endeavour of theirs.

**The Heart and Sole Run 4** consisted of 4 run categories namely:

- Grit Run(15 Km),
- Heat Run (10 Km),
- Dream Run (5 Km),
- CitizenCredit Run (1.5Km).

The runs happened virtually by online registrations while keeping in mind the ingenuousness of the run, all of which was hosted by our official ticketing partner youtoocanrun. The runners had the freedom to run from anywhere and at anytime between the 13th and 14th of March, 2021. Further on, they had to upload the screenshot of the run

details to finally get done with their part of donating towards charity and enhancing their mood and health. 

**Debate 2020 report**

Success depends upon rigorous preparation, irrespective of all the odds against it. Overcoming all the challenges posed by the Covid-19, Fr. Conceicao Rodrigues College of Engineering has successfully hosted its Flagship event, Conceicao Rodrigues Memorial Debate (CRMD), from 6th to 8th of November, 2020. For the first time, this event was held online but that did not take away the enthusiasm professed by the debaters or the judges who partook in this prestigious event.

Encompassing everything from the socio-economic situation of the world due to COVID-19 to political expediency, the theme for CRMD 2020 was – *“Immanent Critique of Social Adiphora”*

CRMD is an intermediate Oxford-style debate competition and has always been praised by people who have witnessed it. Teams from all over India eagerly anticipate bagging the esteemed trophy with their debating intrepidity. The event was hosted on two popular video conferencing platforms, Google Meet and Zoom. The Quarterfinals, Semi-finals and Final debates were live on YouTube as well to ensure an immersive experience for all our viewers.

The much-anticipated debate had 32 laudable teams from all over the nation, grappling with their words for the first prize of Rs. 40,000, second prize for 25,000 and Rs. 7,500 for the best speaker and the best adjudicator. Teams from 12 states competed hard through the league rounds to acquire their positions in the quarter-finals.

Not only centring on the strengths and weaknesses of an argument but also providing frank but constructive feedback to each team to help them better, our Judges, who included experts from the field of Communication, Education, and Corporate world, judged every debate with immense grace and eloquence.


Following were the Judges for the Finals of CRMD' 20 -



## Debate2019

**“A Man is But the Product of His Thoughts; What He Thinks He Becomes”-Mahatma Gandhi**

With Gandhiji's ideology engraved in our minds and hearts, the 20<sup>th</sup> edition of Fr Conceicao Rodrigues Memorial Debate ( CRMD) was held on 28 and 29 September, 2018. It witnessed mind boggling debates with sword sharpening ideas from various intellectual debaters from different colleges across the nation.

CRMD gives students creative room to express their views and serves as a platform where they can articulate their thoughts, showcase their debating skills and fulfil their appetite for more information. Furthermore, the length and breadth of knowledge that they gain through this is simply unparalleled.

The **theme** for this year's national level debate competition was “ **Hegemony of Moral Absolutism**”.


