Journey of our Alumni



Shareen Kitterman

Dear CRCEites,
I am humbled and grateful to share my experiences. Becoming a US Diplomat is a dream come true and I believe that my life is a page to riches, knytale in every sense of the way and not just financial.

It all started with the excellent foundation from my school (CGC) and CRCE. I grew up poor and an outcast since my parents separated in 1979 when I was not yet six. As a cleric's daughter, I was mocked for aspiring to become an engineer. CRCE was my first dream come true. I cannot thank Dr. Jay and the entire staff - they not only educated us but also gave us opportunities to lead and excel. I was fortunate to be the first ladies representative in the student council and part of the founders of Epiphany - our first college festival.

My second dream that came true was moving to the US for grad school. I did not know anyone here but took the leap of faith and left India. I was able to get an assistantship which paid my tuition and living expenses so I graduated debt free. I used to complain about things that I had to 'putt' but I applied the knowledge I had learned at CRCE and the Master's program was a breeze. I followed the typical path of becoming a programmer and I had to bid my time and I got my green card.

After grad school, I worked in the telecommunication sector as a programmer. I wanted to move into management but I did not have a green card (GC). After my GC, I joined a small company, as a Project Manager, building complex solutions for the health insurance sector. I grew the account by millions of dollars and my direct report team from 2 to 60. I was a young manager (early 30s) applying the teachings and leadership skills from CRCE. To increase profitability, I created a business plan to offshore work to India in 2004. I had the partnerships in India successfully and was promoted to a Director within 3 years of joining.

The next phase of my life started with my marriage to Damon who was an immigration attorney and then became a US diplomat. While he was posted in India, I worked for a joint venture of Daimler and ThyssenKrupp as a leader of PMO and marketing. I had no background in marketing other than the willingness to accept challenges and opportunities that came my way. When we returned to the US, I joined Daimler and ThyssenKrupp as a sales role in the US federal government sector without the benefit of sales or governmental experience. I managed to craft and give opportunities to speak at conferences, work with congressional staff and support government audits.

Interacting with Damon and his coworkers inspired me to pursue the Foreign Service. I had to learn US history, civics and various things that one typically learns in school. When I first started this journey, I had no idea that I would fall in love with the history and the Constitution of the United States of America.
