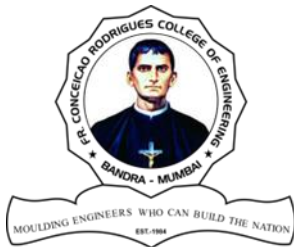
2. Purpose and Objective:

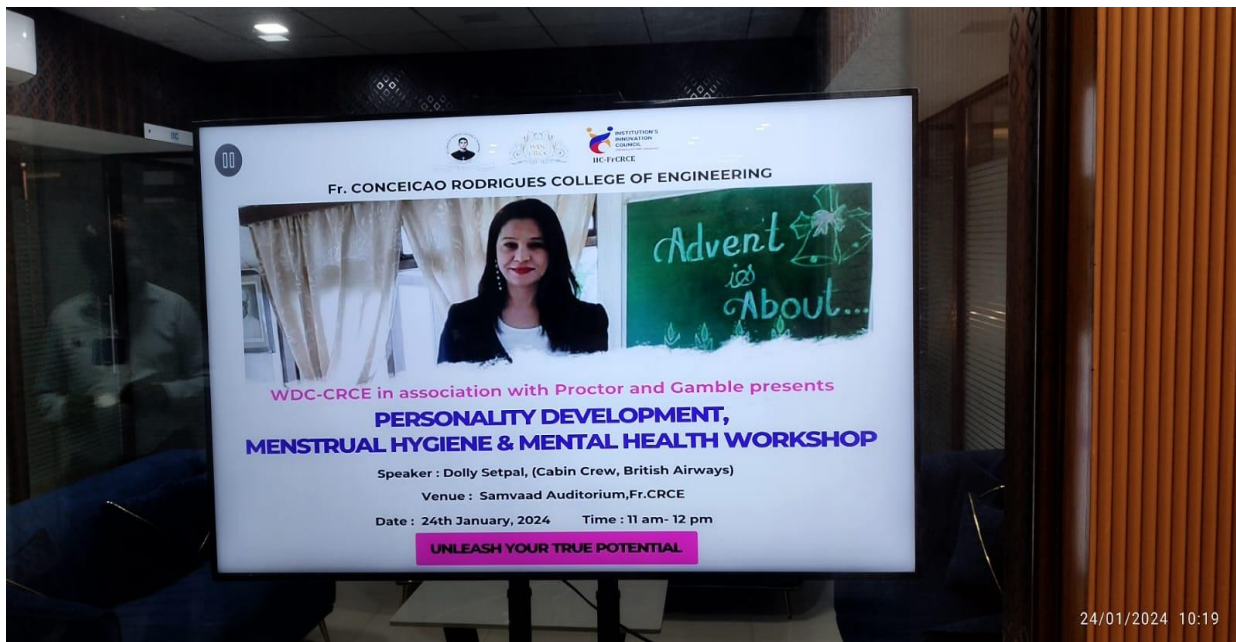

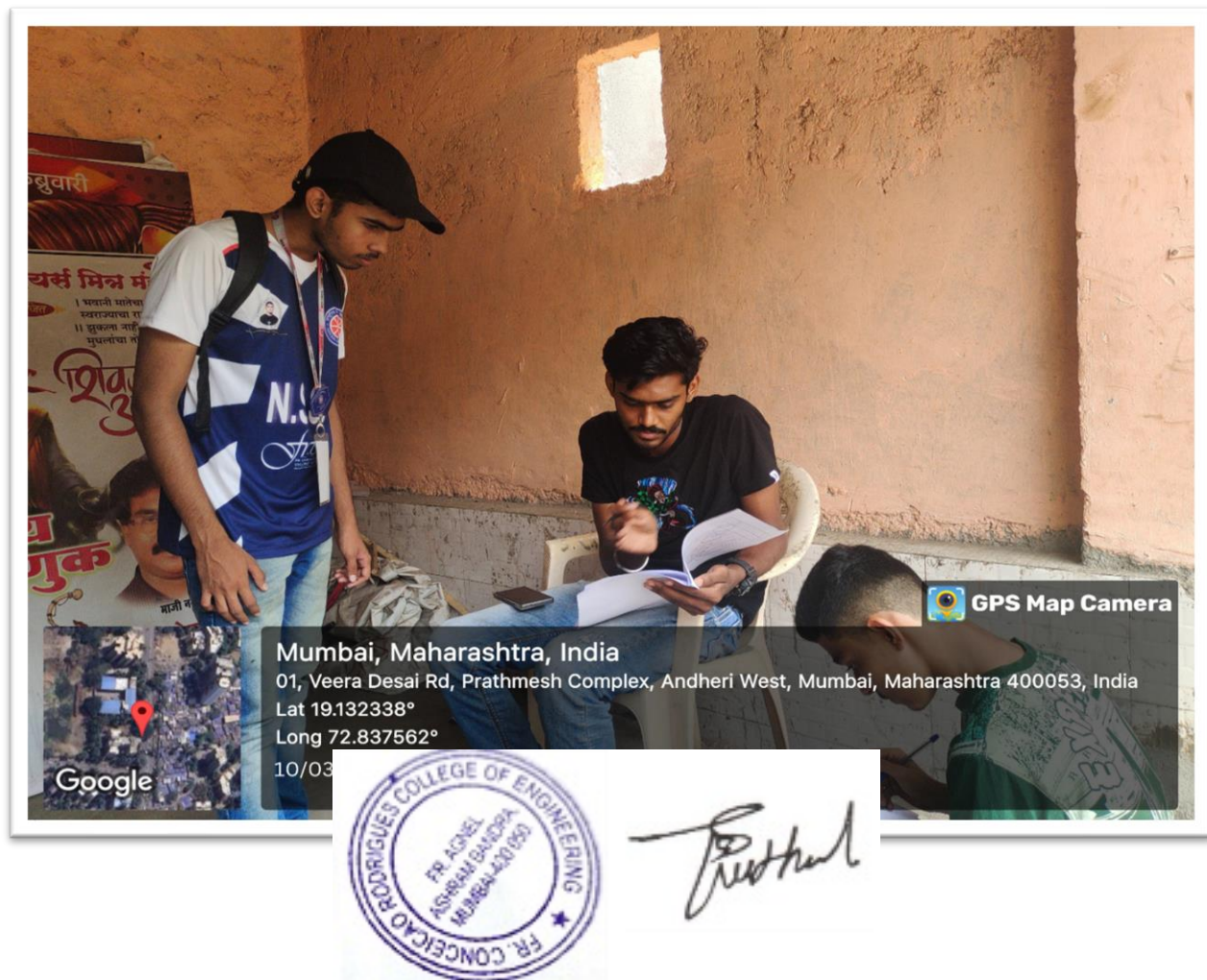

Types of mangrove forests

- Mangrove forests along open bays and lagoons that are getting full sun are considered to be mangrove fringe.
- An over wash forest is similar to a fringe forest except the entire forest is an island that becomes flooded at high tide. Isolated from the main land and terrestrial predators, it is a popular place for birds to roost.
- Riverine mangrove forests are within river floodplains by the coast and are heavily influenced by the changing seasons.
- Basin mangrove forests extend far inland and occur in inlets, deep bays.
- Dwarf, or scrub, mangrove forests only attain canopy heights of less than 5 feet (1.5 meters) although they contain the same species as the other types of forest. The stunted growth is often due to soil salinity, and rocky soils
